

HOW to calculate your ELECTRICITY BILL

Industrial and Commercial customers experience many of the same issues as do domestic customers. In fulfilling its responsibility to all stakeholders, the Regulated Industries Commission makes no distinction and ensures that it is equally responsive to the needs of all customer classes.

Commercial Customers

Commercial customers are billed at either:

- Rate B for customers who use up to 4999 kWh bi-monthly; or
- Rate B1 for customers who use a minimum of 5000 kWh bi-monthly.

To calculate your bill if you are a Rate B customer:

- Step 1. Multiply your bimonthly kWh usage by 38 cents
- Step 2. Add the Customer Charge of \$25.00.
- Step 3. Add VAT to the total.

For example, if your bimonthly consumption is 2500 kWh:

2500 x \$0.38 \$ 950.00 \$ 25.00 Customer Charge Subtotal \$ 975.00 **VAT @ 15%** \$ 146.25 TOTAL \$ 1121.25

To calculate your bill if you are a Rate B1 customer:

- Step 1. Multiply your bimonthly kWh usage by 58 cents
- Step 2. Add the Customer Charge of \$25.00.
- Step 3. Add VAT to the total.

For example, if your bimonthly consumption is 7500 kWh:

7500 x \$0.58 \$ 4350.00 Customer Charge \$ 25.00 Subtotal \$ 4375.00 **VAT @ 15%** \$ 656.25 TOTAL \$ 5031.25
