Good day.

Citizens in the Rio Claro / Mayaro area request the following from the T&TEC:

1) Maintenance of overhead powerlines with the cleaning of floral parasites. In the countryside we have high avian populations of varying varieties. Their droppings on the lines contribute to abundant floral growth on the lines which are seldom removed by the T&TEC.

2) Too many areas have non-functional, mal-functioning or no street lighting at all. We need this to be addressed urgently as a matter of safety and security.

3) Allow customers to retain a bi-monthly billing cycle or move to the proposed monthly cycle. Many customers are contented of the present arrangement and expect a minimal increase thus not creating a burden. The convenience of paying bi-monthly rather than monthly will be disturbed.

By filling in a simple form and ticking one's billing cycle choice will then be transferred to the commission's system and bills can be generated accordingly. I personally would prefer to remain in the bi-monthly cycle.

4) T&TEC Rio Claro/Mayaro response teams on the field are generally efficient to distress calls and need to be complimented. The service provided by the field teams is very satisfactory, most of the time.

5) Greater investments into solar street lights are recommended.
